Upper Oxford Board of Supervisors held an advertised work session at the township building, 1185 Limestone Road, Russellville, PA on Monday, July 25, 2016 at 7:00 P.M.

The work session was called to order by the Chairman, Scott Rugen.

HOSANNA CHURCH – The Hosanna Church deed information was discussed with the Upper Oxford Township Historic Commission. There appear to be some questions as to who actually owns the premises. The UOTHC has been working on gathering deed information and historical documents in an effort to bring clarity to the ownership issue. No response has been received from Lower Oxford Township regarding the letter sent requesting information about the public water and sewer connections. The township zoning officer reported that he confirmed with the OASA that the church is not listed in their records as a customer, thus leading to the possibility the utility connections are through Lincoln University. The Historic Commission will consider contacting Lincoln University for any information that may be pertinent to the ownership issue and utility connections. Right to Know requests maybe contemplated in the future by the Upper Oxford Township Historic Commission to obtain additional information.
